

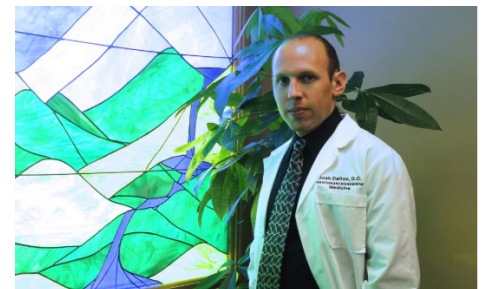
Full Body Rapid OMT Treatments: Recumbent Axial Relief & Appendicular Integration
