Course Description

This 3-hour interactive virtual course is intended to help ONMM residency graduates prepare for the NMM/OMM written board certifying examination. This course will be delivered via virtual methods as determined by AAO, and will include significant real-time audience response participation.

We will review the questions, discuss strategies for writing the questions and identify the correct answer.
